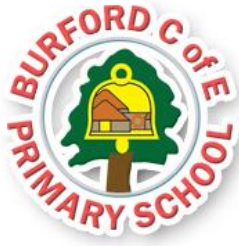
- Accountable for ensuring the vision of BAET is implemented and embedded effectively within the school.
