Woodlands is a specialist school for pupils with social, emotional and mental health (SEMH) difficulties. Some pupils have additional needs including learning difficulties, autism and a range of associated needs, leading to them presenting challenging behaviour. The number of pupils on roll has been increasing recently and the secondary 11-16 provision will cater for up to 56 boys and girls from across the whole of the county of Shropshire. In addition to the secondary school Woodlands also has separate Key Stage 2 provision in the north and south of the county with up to 12 children on roll. Woodlands is also home to a fully traded Outreach Service, offering support and advice to schools across the county, and in some neighbouring Local Authorities, supporting learning, behaviour and ASC; IT support is also offered from within the service.

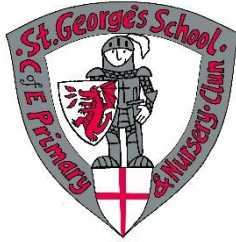

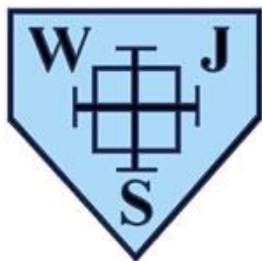
